- Document Types
- Accessibility features
- The Semantic web and "Web 2.0"
- CSS levels 1,2, and level 3, and how you can use them to make site-wide changes instantly and effortlessly, including how to add a "printer-friendly" version of each page on your site.
- JavaScript — when to use it, when not to use it, and what you can do with it.
- Web site optimization techniques to make even the most demanding designs load super-quickly.

Lessons will not cover specific web design software tools like *Macromedia Dreamweaver, Adobe GoLive, or Nvu*, but instead cover the most-often overlooked parts of web design—the underlying code you work with—so you'll instantly recognize how to work with any tool you encounter and never need to rely on one specific product again. **And, I promise, we'll cover it in a way you can easily understand.
